A. E. "Buster" Page, age 87, of Huron passed away peacefully at his home on Monday, May 16, 2011 following a long illness. He is survived by his wife, Ilene Blankenship Page, to whom he had been married for 68 years. He is also survived by two children and their spouses: a son, Dr. Tommy W. Page and wife Stephanie of Huron and a daughter, Patricia Page "Patti" Harden and husband Tony of Jackson; grandchildren Paige Powers (Brett) Wessell of Okemah, OK, Emily Page (David) Steele of Beatrice, AL, Amy Page of Memphis, and Adam Page of Brentwood; and one great-grandchild Eileen Patricia Steele of Beatrice, AL.

Mr. Page was a veteran of World War II and served from 1943 to 1945. He fought in major campaigns throughout Europe and was a member of the Third Division, Seventh Regiment. Among other honors, he was awarded the Purple Heart and Good Conduct Medals.

Mr. Page was a farmer and logger and a member of Mifflin Baptist Church, where he served as deacon. He was an avid outdoorsman and loved hunting and fishing. He truly loved the country life and enjoyed nothing more than being on his farm.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Charlie and Lessie Page; a son, James Etheridge Page; a brother, Kenneth Page; and two sisters, Ocie Mae (Walter) Hancock and Nettie (Albert Jay) Jones.

He is also survived by three brothers and their spouses, Amos (Lavelle) Page, Charles (Mary Nell) Page, and Robert (Billie Jean) Page and a sister-in-law,
