Mrs. Barbara Jean Stevenson, age 63, died Tuesday afternoon, July 10th at her residence. She was a registered nurse who worked with the Henderson County Community Hospital for the last fifteen years. She is survived by her husband of twenty-five years, Richard Stevenson; her sons: James and Randy Geater, her grand children: Cameron, Logan and Emma Geater and her brothers: Dan and Paul Redmonds.
