



Bennie G. Flake

Funeral services for Mr. Bennie G. Flake, age 89, are scheduled for 1:00 PM, Thursday, November 10, 2011 in the chapel of Pafford Funeral Home with Dan Hughes officiating. Interment will follow in Parkers Crossroads Cemetery. Mr. Flake passed away Saturday at the Oaks Care Center in Pineville, Louisiana. He was born October 19, 1922 in Wildersville, Tennessee to the late Willie G. and Flora Adams Flake. He was a retired Lt. Col. With the U. S. Air Force, having flown in WWII, then serving in the Reserve until 1972. He flew 104 combat missions in 8 campaigns and was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross, 5 Bronze Stars for air offenses, an air medal with 4 oakleaf clusters, and Distinguished Unit Badge with the 86th Fighter Group. Following his military career, he attended Georgia Tech. He was an employee of Procter and Gamble at the Milan Arsenal from 1951-55. He then moved to the home office in Cincinnati until 1968, and later transferred to the Alexandria, LA plant, where he worked until his retirement in 1983. He was preceded in death by one sister, Dorothy McDaniel. Survivors include his wife of 62 years, Mrs. Ruth Flake of Pineville, LA, four sons, William Stuart Flake (Linda) of Russellville, AR, Michael Andrew Flake of Pineville, LA, Barrett Adams Flake(Kathy) of London, England, and John Christopher Flake (Shirley) of Baton Rouge, LA, three daughters, Mary Carol Flores (Carlos) of Tegucigalpa, Honduras, Deborah Ruth Fronabarger (Alan) of Buna, TX, and Emily Frances Smith (Charles) of New Roads, LA, one brother, Roy Flake (Mary) of Eads, TN, one sister, Juanita Neisler of Lexington, seventeen grandchildren, and

fifteen great grandchildren.
