



Billy W. Stanfill

February 9, 1929 - July 15, 2009

Funeral services for Mr. Billy W. Stanfill, age 80, are scheduled for 2:00 PM, Friday, July 17, 2009 at First Baptist Church of Lexington with Dr. Hoyt Wilson, Rev. George Reed, and Rev. Gilbert Cubbison officiating. Burial will follow in Lexington City Cemetery with Masonic Rites and Full Military Honors. Pafford Funeral Home of Lexington is in charge of arrangements. Mr. Stanfill died early Wednesday in Jackson. He was born February 9, 1929 in Henderson County to the late Hicks and Drexel Blankenship Stanfill. Mr. Stanfill served over 35 years in the Tennessee Army National Guard and retired as a Lt. Colonel from the Army Reserves. He was a long time commander at the Lexington Armory and also studied military science at the University of Southern Mississippi. He was a 32nd degree Mason at Constantine Masonic Lodge, with 50 years of service. He was a past president of the Lexington Jaycees, a charter member of Pine Tree Country Club, and served as Henderson County Purchasing Agent for 24 years. Mr. Stanfill was also the retired owner of Stanfill's Hardware. He was preceded in death by a son, Brian D. "Bubby" Brooks. Survivors include his wife of 46 years, Mrs. Jo Lanier Stanfill of Lexington, three sons, Jerry (Machelle) Stanfill of Jackson, David Stanfill and close friend, Melanie Morris of Paris, and Stewart (Tina) Stanfill of Lexington, four daughters, Donna (Randall) Lomax, Yvette Blankenship of Lexington, Susie (Danny) Hudson of Sharon, and Julie (David) Brooks of Jackson, three brothers, Bennie, Fleetwood, and Frank Stanfill all of Lexington, a sister, Wilma Moffitt of Lexington, seventeen grandchildren, and

sixteen great grandchildren.

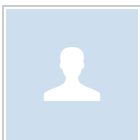
