Funeral services for Charles Elton Page, age 83, are scheduled for 4:00 PM Sunday, July 24, in the chapel of Pafford Funeral Home with Rev. Darrell Pollock and Rev. Jerry Biggers officiating. Interment will follow in the Henderson County Memory Gardens Cemetery.

Mr. Page, the son of the late Charlie E. and Lessie Verann Powers Page, passed away peacefully Friday, July 22, 2016, with his family at his bed side at Jackson Madison County General Hospital at 4:10 PM. He would have been 84 years old October 17.

Pastor Page founded Church of the Lord Jesus Christ in Lexington in 1968 and had pastored many other congregations throughout Tennessee. He served as Secretary for the Tennessee District of the Assemblies of the Lord Jesus Christ for many years. He is a current member of Apostolic Ministers Fellowship. He mentored hundreds of ministers and supported many missionaries with his knowledge and gifts. He was a retired accomplished MIG welder and was awarded many honors for his expertise in welding. Mr. Page was a devoted son, husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother and a beloved uncle to his many nieces and nephews. He had a great sense of community involvement that was instilled to him by his school master, Mr. Berthel Johnson. During his time as a student he provided comfort, warmth and food for his classmates. His greatest accomplishment

was acing the GED test in 1980 with no academic schooling since elementary school. He was known as an accomplished storyteller who could bring stories alive with humor and wit. Pastor Page left impressions on the heart and soul of everyone he came in contact with. He was greatly loved by all who knew him and will be sorely missed.

He is survived by his five daughters: Charlotte Ann Myracle of Corinth, MS, Mary Catherine "Cathie" (Eddie) White, Carolyn Annette (Frank Jr.) Morimanno of Dresden, Cindy Ruth Page of Lexington and Carrie Verann (Toby) Warren of Wildersville; 9 grandchildren: Sammy Don Myracle Jr., David Allen Myracle, Donna Ann Myracle Michael, Anthony Derrick Myracle, James Elton White, Megan Renae White Rock, Frank Lee "Trey" Morimanno III, Anna Renee Warren and Jonathan Andrew Warren; and seventeen great grandchildren. 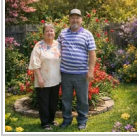

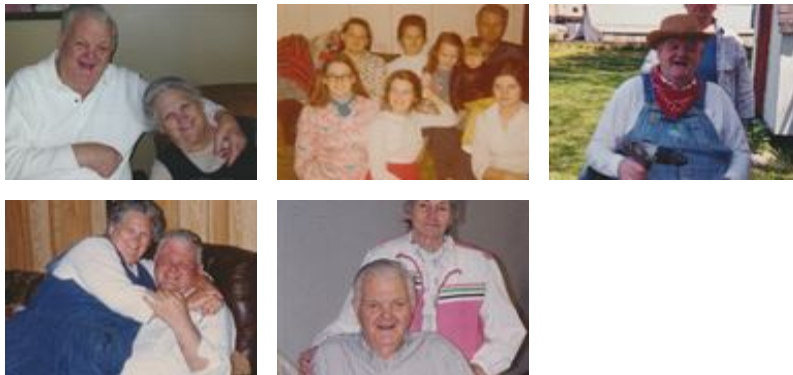
