



## David Lee Robison

September 21, 1937 - January 15, 2009

Funeral services will be held for David Robison at 2:00PM, Saturday, January 17, 2009 at Pafford Funeral Home with Bro. David Buffaloe officiating. Burial will follow in the Rock Hill Cemetery.

Mr. Robison died at his home on January 15th, 2008 after a period of declining health.

He was a graduate of Lexington High School and served with the 30th Armored Division of the Tennessee National Guard. Mr. Robison was born and raised in the Rock Hill community and continued to live there with his wife, Jean Blankenship Robison. They owned and operated an extensive farming operation which included hogs, cattle, and row crop. Mr. Robison also owned and operated a stationary sawmill on a custom-cut basis, he then became a machinest with Delevan and Harding Machine Company. His interests included bird hunting, playing cards (Rook), and boating. He was a long-time member of Rock Hill Baptist Church and served on the cemetery committee for a number of years.

David is survived by one daughter, Jeannie (Jesse) Hogg of Lexington; one son, Bentley (Sherry) Robison of Sylva, NC; two sisters, Betty Jo Pierson of Germantown and Robbie (Gene) Rhodes of Lexington; and three grandchildren, Jessilyn, Jordan, and James Allen Hogg.
