Rev. Donald Ray Garner, age 70, passed to a better life surrounded by his loving family on December 14, 2012, at his home in Lexington, TN after a long battle with PLS. Funeral services will be held at Center Hill Holiness Church, near Lexington on Sunday, December 16 at 3:00 p.m. Burial will immediately follow the funeral at the church cemetery.

Donald Garner was born in Lexington, TN on July, 24, 1942 to the late Mr. J.C. and Mrs. Vera Garner. He lived his young life in the Henderson County area attending the Palestine Community School. He graduated from Lexington High School with the Class of 1960 and then attended West Tennessee Business College. He spent several years in the sales industry with Tom's Snack Foods and Tastee Bread.
