Donna Mae Reed Frizzell, age 95, died Sunday, September 6, 2009. She was the widow of the late John L. Frizzell and is survived by four sons: Ray Frizzell (Patsy) of Nashville, David Frizzell (Jenny) and Danny Frizzell (Susan), both of Lexington and Gregory Frizzell (Sandy) of Oklahoma City, OK; and a daughter, Janice Frizzell Garner of Medina. She also leaves seven grandchildren, thirteen great-grandchildren and one great great grandchild.

She and her husband were founders of Frizzell Family Shoe Store which was family-owned and operated in Lexington for fifty-five years. Donna Mae was a member of the First Baptist Church of Lexington since 1947 and at the time of her death was the church's oldest living member.
