



Elder Cloyce E. Beecham

Funeral services for Elder Cloyce Edward Beecham are scheduled for 2:00pm, Thursday, October 20, 2005 at First Pentecostal Church in Lexington with Bro. Henry Mobley, Bro. O. T. Cottrell, and Bro.
