



## Harold Pollock

August 20, 1929 - September 1, 2010

Funeral services for Mr. Harold Pollock, age 81, are scheduled for 2:00 PM, Friday, Sept. 3, 2010 at First United Pentecostal Church in Lexington with Rev. Bobby Beecham, Rev. David Beecham, and Rev. He was born August 20, 1929 in Henderson County to the late George W. and Ida Wallace Pollock. He was a Korean War Veteran, serving in the U. S. Air Force. He was a retired farmer and a Henderson County School Bus Driver for over 25 years. He was an active member of First United Pentecostal Church for 50 years, serving as song leader, Trustee, and a Sunday School Teacher. He also was active with Station 6 of the Henderson County Fire Department for 30 years and the Jackson Area Plectral Society. He was preceded in death by 2 brothers and 3 sisters.
