Henry Edgar Butters, II died Tuesday, July 15, 2008 at Henderson County Community Hospital, Lexington, TN. He was born in Exeter, Maine, on March 7, 1924, the son of Annie Jeanette (nee Buswell) and Jerauld Wellington Butters. He was a graduate of Corinna Union Academy in Corinna, ME and the University of Maine at Orono, ME. He received his Masters Degree in Poultry Nutrition at Purdue University in Lafayette, Indiana. Mr. Butters was a Veteran of WWII, having served in the U.S. Army, overseas, at the Battle of the Bulge. He was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Post#1294, Lexington, TN.
