Funeral services for Mr. James Henry Hayes, age 85, are scheduled for 2 PM, Thursday, January 29, 2015 at The Pentecostal Church of Darden with Bro. Vaughn Hamm and Bro. Ronnie Parrish officiating. He was born December 17, 1929 in Henderson County to the late Hollie and Hester Wood Hayes. He was retired from Brown Shoe, was a U. S. Army Veteran serving during the Korean Conflict, and was a member of The Pentecostal Church of Darden. Mr. Hayes was also an electrician, cattle and hog farmer, enjoyed wood working and carpenter work, collected tractors and hard hats, worked with buffalo, and was truly a "jack-of-all-trades". 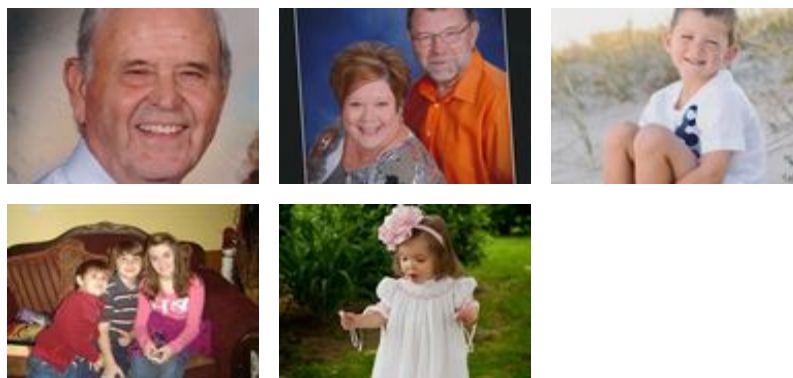
