



## James "Red" Percy

February 27, 1929 - September 8, 2012

Funeral services for Mr. James (Red) Percy, age 83, are scheduled for 2:00 PM Monday, September 10 at the First Baptist Church of Lexington with Rev. Tommy Crocker, Dr. Mike Adams and Rev. Gilbert Cubbison officiating. Interment will follow in Henderson County Memory Gardens.

Mr. Percy, the son of the late H.A. and Effie Page Percy, died late Saturday, September 8, 2012 at his residence. A lifelong resident of Henderson County, "Red" was a faithful member of the First Baptist Church of Lexington where he served as a deacon, a former Sunday School teacher, and President of the Jack Hay Sunday School Class. Before his retirement in 2006 he worked and served in a number of different roles: a poultry farm, Jones Block Company, a dry cleaners in Jackson, Henderson Farmers Coop and Tenn. Farmers Feed Mills in Jackson, Lexington Electric Service, Henderson County Sherriff 1972-1976, Magnetek and Young Touchtone. During all of these years he enjoyed farming and raising cattle. In addition to this, he was a fifty year Mason, a Royal Arch, Shriner and member of the Sunset Chapter of the Eastern Star. Of all of his accomplishments, he was most proud to be a devoted husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather.

Survivors include his wife of sixty-four years, Mary Percy; his daughters: Jamella Hayes, Becky Minor, Susan (John) Webb and Vicki (Rick) Denton; his son, Randy Percy; nine grandchildren, nine great grandchildren; and his

sister, Katherine Doyle.
