Mr. James P. Ross, age 89, died Friday, July 5, 2013 at the Tennessee State Veterans Home in Humboldt, TN. James was born October 18, 1923 to the late William R. and Dovie D. Ross. He served in the Army during the Normandy Invasion and many other engagements in World War II. His career consisted of employment as a lineman at Lexington Electric System; later on was a co-owner of McCollum and Ross Beauty Salon in Lexington and McCollum and Ross Beauty School in Jackson, TN. He was a Mason and a member of Woodmen of the World Organization and member of the VFW. He was also a member of Englewood Baptist Church.
