



## Jesse Glynn Brasher

August 6, 1922 - October 19, 2002

Funeral services for Mr. Jesse Glynn Brasher are scheduled for 2:00pm, Tuesday, Oct. 22, 2002 in the chapel of Pafford Funeral Home in Scotts Hill with J. W. Whittle officiating. Burial will follow in Bethel Cemetery near Scotts Hill with full military honors. Mr. Brasher died early Saturday, October 19 at the Veteran's Hospital in Nashville. He was born August 6, 1922 in Scotts Hill. He was a U. S. Army combat veteran, serving in WWII with Merrill's Marauders, 5307th Composite Unit who fought in the China Burma India Theater. He received the Bronze Star, the Combat Infantryman's Badge, the Asian Pacific Service Medal, the Distinguished Unit Badge, & the Good Conduct Medal. He was a member of the American Legion and the Ebenezer Lodge. He drove a school bus for 39 years in Decatur County and farmed. He was a member of the Scotts Hill Church of Christ. Survivors include his wife, Dorothy Brasher of Scotts Hill, his daughter, Bonita Brockman of Clarksville, a brother, Benny Raymond Brasher of Lincoln, NE, a sister, Melba Sullivan of Scotts Hill , and two grandchildren, Sarah Brockman and Jared Smith.
