They both worked very hard in the church, JoAnn was a Sunday School Teacher, Sunday School Secretary, VBS teacher, worked in Ladies ministries, and she even won Mother of the Year once. She was a great Prayer warrior and her church family was her family. She also enjoyed working for the Community, as a judge in the elections and

volunteering her time in the local Hospital. Upon retirement, they moved to Scotts Hill, TN on August 5, 1996. JoAnn attended Trinity Assembly of God, where she enjoyed the services and activities, especially the Ladies Seminars. She participated in the Scotts Hill Red Hat Ladies where she made many new friends.

Mrs. Blakney was preceded in death by husband, Lonnie N. Blakney; her sister, Wynna Faye Mounts; and her brother, Archie Hall.

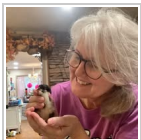

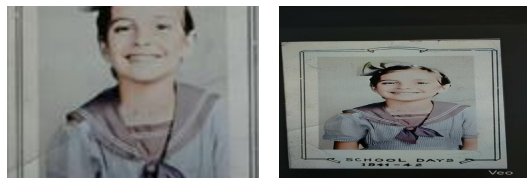
