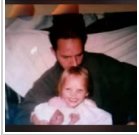

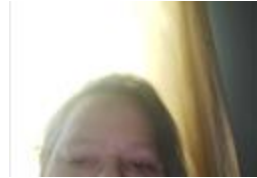
“ Judy,

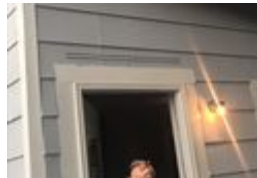
