



Julia Collins Wells

November 4, 1924 - June 29, 2004

Funeral services for Mrs. Julia Collins Wells are scheduled for 2:30pm, Friday, July 2, 2004 at First Presbyterian Church in Jackson, followed by a brief interment service for family only at Spain Cemetery near Cedar Grove. Mrs. Wells died Tuesday, June 29, 2004 at University Hospital in Cincinnati, Ohio after an anoxic brain injury suffered while having dinner with her family. Mrs. Wells was born in November of 1924 in Tallahassee, Florida to the late Mr. & Mrs. William Kenneth Collins. She graduated from Leon High School in Tallahassee and attended Florida State College for Women (now, Florida State University) where she was a member of Chi Omega Women's Fraternity. Mrs. Wells was a person of strong Christian faith, a homemaker and a faithful member of First Presbyterian Church in Jackson. Mrs. Wells suffered from CMT, an illness that left her physically handicapped for the last 10 years of her life. During this time, she and her family so appreciated the excellent in home care she received from a very special friend, Mrs. Roseanna Simmons. Mrs. Wells is survived by her husband of 59 years, Mr. Fred Milton Wells of Jackson, her son, Alan K. Wells, and wife Trina of Hickory Valley, TN, her daughter, Julia Elizabeth Eaton, and husband William C. Eaton of Noblesville, IN, a sister, Elizabeth Collins Swaim and husband, J. Richard Swaim of Jackson, seven grandchildren, and a great granddaughter, Lauren Elizabeth Eaton. Preceding the services on Friday, the family will receive friends beginning at 1:30pm, in Memorial Hall at First Presbyterian Church in Jackson.
