Affectionately known as Momom, Momaw, and Memaw, she treasured every moment spent with them. Whether sharing stories, laughter, or simply sitting together, those moments became lasting memories for her family.

Linda also had a fondness for good Southern cooking especially when someone else did the cooking. She appreciated the simple joys of life, from a hearty meal to time spent gathered around the table with those she loved most.
