Funeral services for Lottie Lee Hay will be held at Pafford Funeral Home in Lexington, Tennessee at 2 PM on Monday, December 10, 2018. Burial will follow in Henderson County Memory Gardens. The family will receive friends on Sunday from 1-3 PM and on Monday from 11 AM – 2 PM.
