Funeral services for Mrs. Lucille Jones, age 88, are scheduled for 11:00 AM Monday, September 3 in the chapel of Pafford Funeral Home with Rev. William Jones officiating. Interment will follow in the Lexington Cemetery.

Mrs. Jones, the daughter of the late Wilson Arthur and Jenny Mae Shipman Tuck, died Saturday, September 1, 2012. She was a retired kindergarten teacher and touched the lives of thousands of children in her thirty plus years with Caywood Elementary School of Lexington.
