



## Ms. Margie Wallace

August 25, 1933 - February 22, 2022

A life well lived may be the best way to describe the life and passing of Mrs. Margie Britt Wallace who died late Tuesday afternoon, February 22, 2022 at the age of 88. 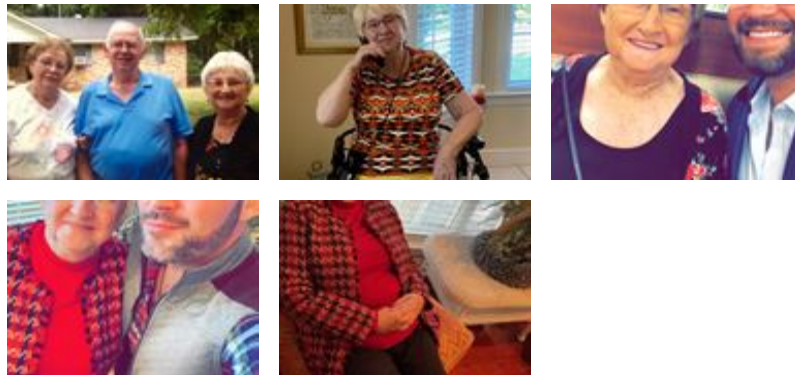
