



Marshall Easley

September 19, 1926 - February 13, 2008

Funeral services for John Marshall Easley, age 81, will be held at 1:00 PM, Monday, February 18 at the St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church with Charles Thomason, Rev. Norman Carver and Rev. Percy Smith officiating. Interment will be at Cooper's Grove Cemetery near Lexington.

Mr. Easley, a long time licensed funeral director, died Wednesday evening, February 13, 2008 at Henderson County Community Hospital. Marshall, a 1950 graduate of Montgomery High School, was a community leader and involved in many worthwhile endeavors. He was a member of St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church where he served as a deacon; a member of the Loyal Order of the Eastern Star; and enjoyed the fellowship and activities at the Lexington Henderson County Senior Citizens Center. In his younger years, Marshall was a longtime and faithful employee of Pafford Funeral Home until he lost his eyesight to glaucoma but he continued his work as a funeral director with Peoples Funeral Home.

Survivors include three sons: John C. Easley (LaRuth), Dennis O'Neal Easley (Gladys) and Cecil Easley and his daughter, Virginia Easley all of Lexington. There are 9 grandchildren and 8 great grandchildren. Marshall was preceded in death by his wife, Addie Lee Carver Easley, a son, Raymond Eugene Easley and a daughter Cassandra Easley who died at birth.

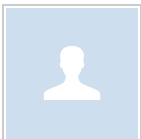
