January 29, 1931 - August 14, 2007

Funeral services for Connie Marshall Williams, Jr. will be held on Thursday, August 16, 2007, at 11:00 a.m. at Pafford Funeral Home in Lexington, Tennessee with Bro. David Buffaloe and Bro. Randall Woods officiating. Burial will follow in Lexington Cemetery. He passed away at his home on Tuesday, August 14, at the age of 76.

Mr. Williams was born January 29, 1931, to the late Connie Marshall (Dick) Williams, Sr. and the late Dixie Lee Winslow Logan Williams of Lexington. He received a diploma in 1948 from Columbia Military Academy. He received an Associate degree in 1950 from Georgia Military College.

He married his high school sweetheart, Mabel Ernestine Rhodes, on August 22, 1948; and she died on February 12, 1960. They had two children, Butch and Babs. Mr. Williams married Jewell Elizabeth Wood on October 9, 1965; and she died on July 3, 1998. They had one son, David. He was predeceased by his parents, sister Mary Frances Williams, and brother Dick Logan.

Mr. Williams retired from Brown Shoe Company in 1993 after 38 years of service. He was a member of the Lexington Masonic Lodge and First United Methodist Church of Lexington.

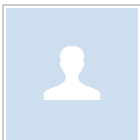
