Funeral services for Mrs. Robbie Lee Wallace, age 90, are scheduled for 2:00 PM Sunday, October 21 in the Chapel of Pafford Funeral Home with Dr. Hoyt Wilson officiating. Interment will follow in Unity Cemetery near Luray.

Mrs. Wallace, the daughter of the late William Franklin and Mary P. Bailey Wadley, died Saturday morning, October 20, 2007 in Lexington. She was a lifelong resident of Henderson County and worked at the courthouse for over fifty years, serving as the counties' first librarian and later serving as Clerk and Master for the county. She held this position longer than anyone in the State of Tennessee and helped countless people with free legal advice over those years. Mrs. Robbie was a member of the First Baptist Church of Lexington for over fifty years as well and during those years touched many lives as a Sunday School teacher for the four and five year olds of the church. Survivors include her brother, Herbert "Jazz" Wadley and his wife Lula Mae, her sister-in-law, Dorothy Jo Wallace all of Luray and many nephews. She was preceded in death by her husband, Alfred R. Wallace Jr. and her brothers: Kenneth and Cratis "Boss" Wadley.
