Bro. Ron Denison, age 70, passed away on Monday, October 31, 2022 in Jackson. He was born June 8, 1952 in Memphis to the late Barry Washington Denison and Hessie Mae Maness Denison. 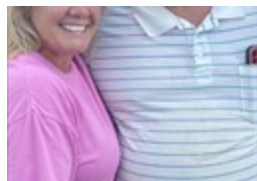

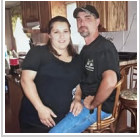
