Roy Hester Mooney was born in the Cedar Grove Community of Henderson County, Tennessee on December 5, 1922. He left this life on November 23, 2008 at the Jackson Madison County General Hospital. One of eleven children born to the late James Ivy and Virgie Alice Mooney, he grew up in the Cedar Grove Community where he attended the local school.
