



Thomas Glynn "Bub" Pollock

July 8, 1954 - August 13, 2012

Funeral services for Thomas Glynn "Bub" Pollock, age 58, will be held at 4 PM on Wednesday, August 15, 2012 at Chapel Hill Baptist Church with Dr. Hoyt Wilson, Bro. Mark Brewer, and Bro. Eddie Martin officiating. Interment will follow in the church cemetery. Pafford Funeral Home of Lexington is in charge of arrangements.

Glynn died Monday afternoon, August 13, 2012 at his Huron residence with his family at his bedside after a 5 month battle with lung cancer. He was a retired employee of Procter and Gamble of Jackson. He was a deacon, Sunday School Director, and member of Chapel Hill Baptist Church. Glynn enjoyed the outdoors, whether it was fishing, hunting, working on the farm, or watching his grandsons play their sports.

He is survived by his wife of 36 years, Sheila Turnbow Pollock, his sons: Christopher Pollock and Jonathan Dean (Candy) Pollock; grandsons: Easton and Mathew Grayson Pollock; brothers: Lynn (Teresa) Pollock and Denny (Tina) Pollock; his mother: Linda Pollock Bell; and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his father, Allen Pollock.
