



## William L. Brooks

Funeral services for Mr. William L. Brooks, age 71, will be held Saturday, August 17, 2002 at 3:00 PM at the First Baptist Church of Lexington. Dr. Hoyt Wilson and Charles Thomason will officiate. Burial will follow in Lexington Cemetery. Mr. Brooks, an Air Force veteran and long time attorney, died suddenly Thursday, August 15 at his residence. He was a graduate of the University of Tennessee at Knoxville and served on the Alumni Public Affairs Committee for over 30 years. Mr. Brooks was a former Alderman for the City of Lexington, a County Commissioner and Assistant Attorney General for the State of Tennessee. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Lexington and for the last ten years, teacher of the Jack Hay Sunday School Class, member and past president of the Lexington Rotary Club, a former Rotarian of the Year and Paul Harris Fellow. In addition he currently serves Henderson County as its attorney. Survivors include his wife, Pat Brooks of Lexington; two sons: Philip Brooks and his wife Susan of Richmond, VA, and Roger Brooks of Nashville; five grandchildren: Will, Sarah, Caleb, Justin and Andrea Brooks.
