



Mr. Willie Wayne Walker

August 16, 1943 - September 1, 2013

Funeral services and Masonic rites for Mr. Willie Wayne Walker, age 70, are scheduled for 2 PM, Thursday, September 5, 2013 at First Baptist Church of Lexington. Interment will follow in Union Cemetery. Pafford Funeral Home of Lexington is in charge of arrangements.

Wayne, a retired pipefitter with Automatic Sprinkler was the son of the late H. D. and Ethel Anderson Walker and was born August 16, 1943 in Henderson County and died unexpectedly Sunday, September 1 at his Lexington residence. He was a faithful member of Union Baptist Church in his early years, later the First Baptist Church of Lexington and a member of the Jack Hay Sunday School Class where he served as the Out Reach director. Wayne was a plural member of the Constantine and Cheap Valley Masonic Lodges, and a three time Past Master; a member of the Memphis Scottish Rite and a life member of the Al Chymia Shrine and their #1 salesman for their Boss Hoss Motorcycle annual fundraiser; in addition he was an avid sports lover, especially Tennessee athletics and the New York Yankees. If you ever met Wayne, you'd leave as a friend.

Survivors include his children, Elizabeth Walker Wormsley of Kingston and John Walker of Lexington; five grandchildren, Shelby and Sydney Wormsley, and Clay, Presley, and Brooklyn Walker, special friend, Jewel Blankenship, and long term caregiver, Mae Mayo. He was preceded in death by his wife,
