



## Zula Bradfield Wilson

April 6, 1922 - June 7, 2007

Funeral services for Mrs. Zula Bradfield Wilson, 85, will be at 11AM, Saturday, June 9, in the chapel of Pafford Funeral Home with P. J. Hardy and Billy Clark officiating. Burial will follow in the Christian Chapel Cemetery in Henderson County. Mrs. Wilson died June 7, 2007 at Decatur County Manor after a lengthy illness. She was preceded in death by her parents, J. L. and Dicie Stephens Bradfield, two brothers, W. A. Bradfield and Luther Bradfield, and three sisters, Lorene Holladay, Pauline Harris, and Lula Rainey.
